The data above reflects our enrollment information as of May 23, 2013. As the report indicates, we have a total of 588 students currently enrolled at T.C. Howe High School. Our EL number is at 63 with our largest number of EL students being enrolled in the 8th grade. We also have a total of 105 students who currently have an IEP.

From May 15, 2013 to May 23, 2013, we have had a total of 79 out of school suspensions with the largest number of suspensions taking place in the 8th grade and the least number of suspensions taking place in the 12th grade. Additionally, during this time period, we have had a total of two expulsions. Our attendance rate for our students is currently 86.8% and our attendance for our faculty is currently 97.2%.
