Woodrow Wilson MBA Fellowship in Education Leadership

Nominations will be accepted **beginning August 15 for the 2017-18 cohort** at the University of Indianapolis. The program provides a business-education hybrid to enhance the skills of current school leaders, or to prepare educators to assume a leadership role after graduation.

The 13-month MBA program includes preparation for principal licensure, postgraduate executive coaching support, and a fellowship that covers all program expenses.

Prospective fellows will be nominated by their school districts, principals, or charter authorizers to be considered for this highly selective 13-month fellowship. Most coursework happens in intensive summer sessions designed to make the most of the time when fellows are not working during the K-12 school year. During the school year, fellows will continue working in their school and also complete MBA projects related to the summer courses.

This program will appeal to candidates who strive to become a principal, superintendent, or other central office administrator.
